It was agreed in principle throughout a meeting with representatives on 21 November 2014 in Emmen that the abovementioned organizations will recognize each other's medical certifications for working on the Dutch and German continental shelf, on the conditions that:

- 1. the assessment of health of persons working or intending to work offshore has been done according to the content of the following medical standards:
 - a. NOGEPA Industry standard 15: "<u>Medical aspects of fitness for work offshore: Guidance</u> for Examining physicians";
 - Association of the Scientific Medical Societies e.V. (AWMF) S1 Guideline: "<u>Medical fitness</u> <u>examinations for employees working on offshore wind parks and other offshore</u> <u>installations</u>" as applied by VGB PowerTech e.V.'s;
- the medical certification has been released after examining by an officially registered physician who has a valid registration according to Article 1.4.2 respectively Article 1.3 of the abovementioned medical standards; the names of physicians who are possessing a valid registration will be published on the websites of the abovementioned organizations;
- 3. the valid period of the medical certificate has not been expired in the country of issue neither in the accepting country.

Recognition of medical certificates will take place at the own expense and risk of the employer or contractor of the persons working or intending to work offshore.
