

OFFSHORE PASSENGER HELICOPTER-CHECK-IN PROCEDURE HIGHLIGHTS



MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR OFFSHORE VISIT



Valid passport. (no ID card allowed)

Carry PSL logbook or physical copy of valid offshore medical certification, NOGEPa 0.5A/B.

Equivalent UK/DK/NOR training may be allowed.

MEDICATION



Recommended to carry doctor's statement for prescribed medication and expected to declare to medic and/or OIM upon arrival offshore. Steroids and needles require professional medical approval.

DRUGS & ALCOHOL POLICY



Not under influence of alcohol or prohibited substances.

Testing may be requested.

Airport is smoke-free, permitted only in designated areas outside the terminal.

PLANNING



Check-in 60 minutes prior to departure for personal baggage: **90 minutes for cargo.**

Maximum 23kg luggage per bag (preferably soft bags) Luggage amount subject to helicopter capacity

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS



Long trousers mandatory throughout the year.

Summer: 2 layers including 1 with long sleeves. (no hoodies) Suits with fixed liner allow only one layer of clothing.

Winter: 3 layers, 1 with long sleeves and no hoodies or high collared shirts.

No open toed shoes, boots or zipped footwear. (laced type only)

CHECK-IN PROCESS



In flight **use of airpods, ear buds and noise-cancelling headsets is prohibited** (insufficient hearing protection)

Attend mandatory helicopter safety briefing.

Green armband use for new passengers.

XBR classification for eXtra Broad Restricted Use of checkered armband for XBR passengers XBR passengers on dedicated XBR seats during flight.



LAPTOPS & TABLETS

Condition: Goods, undamaged

Mode: Switched off

Transport: Protective packaging in helicopter cargohold



MOBILE PHONES

Condition: Goods, undamaged

Mode: Flight safe mode or Switched off

Transport: In flight suit leg pocket



EAR BUDS

Condition: Goods, undamaged

Mode: Turned off where possible

Transport: Protective case in flight suit leg pocket



SMART WATCHES

Condition: Goods, undamaged

Mode: Flight safe mode or Switched off

Transport: Worn or stored in protective case and in flight suit leg pocket



OTHER PEDS

Condition: Goods, undamaged

Mode: Turned off

Transport: Protective packaging in helicopter cargohold



E-cigarettes, powerbanks, spare lithium batteries & lighters

NOT PERMITTED



DRONES

NOT PERMITTED

A protective case is **purpose built protective packaging** that is designed to protect the item from damage or inadvertently switching on. i.e. commonly available hard or soft cases.
